Steps to protect Deceased from Identity Theft













## Documents Needed to Close Social Media Accounts

Can be done by immediate family member or executor of the account holder

**Proof of Death:** Death Certificate (electronic copy)

or

**Proof of Authority:** Submit one to provide proof of authority

## Obtain copies of

- Driver's License
  - Passport
  - Usernames
- Email addresses associated with Social Media Accounts

Power of Attorney
Deceased Birth Certificate
Deceased Will
Estate letter

## Steps to closing Social Media Accounts

Search for "Help Center" on each Platform


Type "Removal of Deceased Account" in Search Box

Follow Instructions from each Platform on Next Steps

Upon completing instructions, verify Account has been removed
